Commonly Asked Questions

Which plastics can be recycled?

The container will show a number inside a triangle of chasing arrows. #1 or #2 can be recycled in our area.

Should I remove caps from my plastic bottles?

Yes. These caps are typically not recyclable.

Do I need to remove labels? No.

Which glass is recyclable?

Beverage bottles and clean food jars. NO windows, drinking glasses, mirrors, dishes, picture frame glass, coffeepots or light bulbs.

What can I do with appliances?

Appliances can be taken to a scrap metal dealer to be recycled.

Is it really necessary to rinse my recyclables?

Yes. Liquids or food residue contaminate the materials and prevent them from being recyclable. Be sure recyclables are clean and dry before recycling.

Can I recycle plastic bags?

Yes. Take bags to a local grocery store (which typically have bins near the entrance) or to the Metro Mobile Recycling Drop-Off Center.
