

## Commonly Asked Questions

### Which plastics can be recycled?

The container will show a number inside a triangle of chasing arrows. #1 - 7 can be recycled in our area.

### Should I remove caps from my plastic bottles?

Plastic caps should be removed and sorted at the County recycling center. Caps may be left on bottles at the City drop-off locations.

### Do I need to remove labels? No.

### Which glass is recyclable?

Beverage bottles and clean food jars. NO windows, drinking glasses, mirrors, dishes, picture frame glass, coffeepots or light bulbs.

### What can I do with appliances?

Appliances can be taken to a scrap metal dealer to be recycled.

### Is it really necessary to rinse my recyclables?

Yes. Liquids or food residue contaminate the materials and prevent them from being recyclable. Be sure recyclables are clean and dry before recycling.

### Can I recycle plastic bags?

Yes. Take bags to a local grocery store (which typically have bins near the entrance).
