OPERATIONAL OVERVIEW: Right of Way Maintenance is responsible for storage of materials which include: sand, clay, topsoil, riprap, limestone, wash sand, and gravel. Inspections of the storage material will be conducted bi-weekly by the Oil Spill Supervisor. Additionally, all ROW Maintenance Personnel and Supervisors will prevent and/or minimize storm water impacts during such work.

STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES:

- 1. Crews shall report to assigned work areas and ensure that all safety protocols are met while on jobsite (wearing Personal Protection Equipment).
- 2. Materials are to be kept in secure storage areas.
- 3. Only authorized personnel are allowed to enter material storage areas.
- 4. Operators are to follow manufacturer's recommended procedures.
- 5. No hazardous material is accepted.
- 6. Material is hauled in by City of Mobile trucks for repair of washouts, cave-ins, shoulders, ditches, and roads graded.
- 7. BMPs are used to ensure stockpiled materials are contained (as needed).
- 8. Ensure material/product is properly loaded, not leaking and covered prior to transport offsite.
- 9. Ensure spill response equipment and supplies are stocked/readily available. If a spill occurs, follow spill response procedures as described in the Spill Response SOP.
- 10. All material usage is recorded on a Daily Worksheet and turned in to the Supervisor by Operators.
